Seats may be booked in Sheffield up to the time of departure of the 'bus, but at all other places they should be booked 2 clear days in advance, and the date of return must also be booked.

Return journey may be taken at any time if accomodation available when booking.

A small amount of luggage will be carried free of charge at owner's risk.

Passengers may be picked up anywhere on the direct route by arrangement when booking.

The Company give notice that they do not undertake that Omnibuses shall start or arrive at the time specified in the Time Table, nor will they be accountable for any loss, inconvenience or injury arising from delay or detention from any cause. The Company reserves the right to alter the times and fares without previous notice.

Children under 3 years of age if not occupying a seat, FREE. Children under 12 years of age half-fare.

In cases where owing to weather or other unforeseen conditions the service of the Company on any route is suspended, the holders of return tickets entitling them to travel on that route will be refunded an amount equal to the difference between the return fare paid and the ordinary single fare.

SINGLE FARES.
